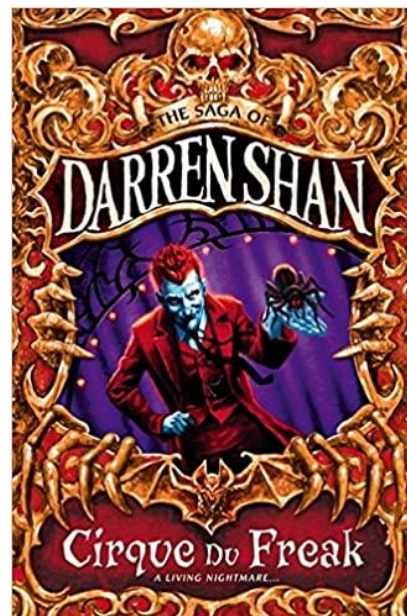


We recommend that pupils do 20 min each day of reading. Although pupils may have books at home we recognise that they may not be the case or they have completed them already or be age appropriate. The current situation makes it difficult for pupils to purchase books or to distribute them from school.

We are asking pupils to make use of the free learning resources from 'Audible'. The site is providing many free audiobooks as part of their school closure provision and includes many great books.

**The first audiobook that we would like pupils to listen to is 'Cirque du Freak' which is a well-reviewed, challenging book that is part of a series if pupils really enjoy it.**
