<b>Keyword</b>	<b>Definition for copy/cover/check</b>	<b>Copy/Cover/Check</b>	<b>Copy/Cover/Check</b>
<b>producer</b>	This person oversees all of the production, from what goes on stage, to back stage crew, marketing etc.		
<b>director</b>	This person is in charge of the drama, dialogue and movement on the stage.		
<b>choreographer</b>	Where there are dance numbers, the choreographer is in charge of routines and movement.		
<b>number</b>	An item in a music production, be it a solo song, dance or chorus.		
<b>jukebox musical</b>	A musical based on a collection of songs by an artist or band.		
<b>book musical</b>	A musical that focuses on a clear plot.
